

## **Verdugo Workforce Development Board Public Meeting – Legal Notice**

The Verdugo Workforce Development Board (VWDB) has developed its Local Workforce Development Plan for 2017 - 2020. The draft plan establishes the types of workforce development activities that will be offered in the Verdugo Workforce Development Area (VWDA), including programs for unemployed job seekers and youth. The Plan will also include programs to assist local businesses to ensure they have the qualified workforce to meet their organizational needs. The VWDA consists of the cities of Burbank, Glendale and La Cañada Flintridge which is governed by a Joint Powers Agreement that creates the Verdugo Consortium.

The VWDB will conduct a Public Meeting to present the Local Plan and solicit comments and recommendations from the community. The VWDB will also present the Los Angeles Basin Regional Plan during this meeting. The public is invited to attend this meeting.

At the Meeting, VWDB staff members will provide:

- An overview of local and regional plan requirements.
- A description of the VWDB's vision for the local workforce development system.
- A description of initiatives developed by the seven Local Boards in the Los Angeles Basin to address the region's major workforce needs and opportunities.
- An outline of the strategies to provide employment services, including career pathways, to various populations in the VWDA including the unemployed, veterans, job seekers with disabilities, low-income residents and youth.
- An overview of the partnerships with local and regional partners and stakeholder to address the needs of jobseekers, youth and business.
- An opportunity for members of the public to make verbal comments on the Plan.

The draft of the Plan will be available for public review and comment prior to the public meeting at [www.verdugoworkforce.com](http://www.verdugoworkforce.com) from February 1, 2017 – March 1, 2017.
