RESOLUTION NO. 12-39

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA CAÑADA FLINTRIDGE DIRECTING STAFF TO ENTER INTO A MILLS ACT CONTRACT FOR 503 DARTMOUTH PLACE

WHEREAS, the Mills Act is a State law enacted in 1972 that encourages the preservation and maintenance of historic structures; and

WHEREAS, the Mills Act permits cities to enter into agreements with owners of qualified historic structures to preserve and maintain their properties, in exchange for the County Assessor assessing their property at a lower rate by utilizing a formula established by the State of California; and

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2012 the City Council approved Ordinance No. 406 pertaining to the enactment of Mills Act contracts providing property tax relief for the preservation of historic properties; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission on October 23, 2012 recommended that the City Council approve a Mills Act Contract for 4166 Woodleigh Lane; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that all the facts contained in the staff report dated November 19, 2012 regarding the Mills Act Contract fee are true and correct, and the City Council adopts said staff report as its own findings of fact; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council does hereby directs staff to prepare a Mills Act Contract for 503 Dartmouth Place;
