

**City of La Cañada Flintridge
Youth Employment
Flint Canyon Repair Project
(Cherry Canyon Trails Improvements)**

Project Detail:

The Flint Canyon Trail is approximately a 2 mile-long trail that runs through the Flintridge area of the City, connecting Hahamongna Park in Pasadena on the east with trails in Cherry Canyon on the west. Over the years, and especially in 2005, the City experienced severe rain storms that caused significant damage to the trails. As a result, various slopes and trail segments were eroded. This project is to repair the downslope.

Scope of Work:

The project consists of clearing and grubbing; unclassified excavation; site grading and compaction; gabion basket wall construction; drainage pipe installation; and finish grading per the project plans and specifications.

Tasks that may be performed by At-Risk Youth:

1. Removal of landscaping and vegetation (10 hours)
2. Excavation (70 hours)

Estimated Hours/Cost:

Estimate cost of youth employment:	80 hours
Estimated Cost per hours:	\$8.00 per hour
Total estimated cost of youth employment:	\$640.00

Method of employing youth:

As part of the projects plans and specifications, the contractor is responsible for seeking at risk youth employment for the project.
