City Manager Delivers Annual Report to City Council *City reports significant activity in 2015*

La Cañada Flintridge, CA – City Manager Mark Alexander delivered his annual report to the City Council on Tuesday, February 16, 2016. Per City ordinance, the City Manager must deliver an annual report to the City Council on the activities and metrics for the different City departments: Administration, Community Development, Finance and Public Works.

As highlighted in the Annual Report, the City actively worked in 2015 to oppose the proposed SR-710 tunnel expansion and submitted comments on the Draft Environmental Impact Report published by Metro and Caltrans. The City also hosted the first “State of the Stations” event where representatives from the Los Angeles County Sheriff’s Department and Los Angeles County Fire engaged the community on important public safety topics.

Major capital improvement projects were completed on various LCF roads and significant investments were made at Lanterman Auditorium during 2015.

The City Manager also reported on a variety of statistics from City Hall. Below are a few highlights:

- Number of Summer Beach Bus rides: 2,749
- Number of free LCF Shuttle rides: 33,449
- Online service requests processed through “Access LCF”: 149
- Number of Dial-a-Ride trips provided to the elderly and disabled: 923
- Number of film and still photo permits issued: 63
- Number of Public Records Requests processed: 340
- Number of Music-in-the-Park concerts: 15
- Issues of the LCF Vista Community Newsletter published: 4
- Number of business licenses issued: 1,809 (1,401 renewals)
- Number of calls fielded by the Community Development Department: 8,394
- Number of walk-ins helped by the Community Development Department: 4,596
- Number of plan checks processed: 1,600
