**14. Items for Future Agendas.**


The Commission would like an update on the status of Olberz Park at a future meeting.

Commissioner Koblin reported that at the last Sports Coalition meeting that the User groups had agreed to contribute a total of \$11,000 to two pending City projects: 1) the refurbishment of field fencing (\$8,500) and 2) the Lanterman Auditorium Restrooms (\$2,500). With the cost share as follows: La Cañada Baseball/Softball \$3,000, AYSO \$3,000, LAFC \$3,000, and Gladiators \$2,000.
