SUBJECT: **Update on Music in the Park Concert Series Scheduling**

RECOMMENDATION:

Parks and Recreation Commission receive and file the update on Music in the Park.

BACKGROUND:

At the February 13th, 2019 Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting, the Commission reviewed and provided feedback to the staff on the 2018 Music in the Park Concert Series. Staff took the comments from the Commission, City Council and the public and began working on securing talent for the 2019 Music in the Park Concert Series.

As of today, all the available slots have been tentatively booked pending final contracts. Few notable groups returning at the request of the Commission are Misplaced Priorities, Woodie and the Longboards, and Live from Earth. There will also be a new Commission recommended band Laurel Canyon performing at this year's Music in the Park Concert series. The Commission also requested to have an Elvis Tribute and variety introduced to the lineup. Scot Bruce Elvis Tribute and a new band called the Funky Hippeez have been tentatively booked for the series. At the request of the Commission Jack Lance Big Band will not return for the concert series. However, due to popularity of the bands and their demand by the Community, Past Action Heroes and Hot August Nights will be returning to this year concert series.

The Commission will preview the final line up at the May Parks and Recreation Commission meeting prior to its release to the public.
