SUBJECT: **Discussion of Community Service Projects**

RECOMMENDATION:

The Parks and Recreation Commission consider various projects and recommend a single project as the community service project for the Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is of La Cañada Flintridge to complete.

BACKGROUND:

Late 2017, the City was approached by the Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is of La Cañada Flintridge, a non-profit organization, to discuss a potential opportunity for a community service project.

City staff has looked at potential projects that the group could work on. The group is aware of these options and open to taking any of the available options on as their project. Below is a list of the pending projects which could be considered:

| Street Name Markings for Trails | Paint street curbs with street name near selected trail head. | Citywide |
| Repair Backstops | Repair/Replace and expand wood portion of the back stops for the baseball fields | Paradise Canyon Elementary, 471 Knight Way |
| Paint Walls at Cornishon Tennis Courts | Two lower walls, wall between courts and wall on the Cornishon Field. The upper most wall has already been completed. | FIS Tennis Courts. Cornishon Avenue |
