SUBJECT: **Identification of Senior Citizen Service Providers within the City of La Cañada Flintridge**

RECOMMENDATION:

Parks and Recreation Commission to review and approve the list of community organization to be invited to a Commission meeting for a presentation on services they provide to the senior citizens of La Cañada Flintridge.

BACKGROUND:

During the City Council's Special Goal Setting meeting, the City Council Discussed a desire to review the services provided within the community addressing both the issues and needs facing Senior Citizens. The City Council requested the issue go before the Parks and Recreation Commission.

At the June 14, 2017 Parks and Recreation Commission meeting, the Commission decided as part of their Senior Citizen Needs Assessment to invite community groups which provide services to Senior Citizens to present to the Commission. These presentations will allow the Commission to learn more about available services and identify areas of need.

Staff has worked with the YMCA and Community Center to generate a list of local organization that provide services to Senior Citizens:

- La Cañada Flintridge Community Center
- Crescenta/Canada YMCA
- Verdugo Hills Hospital
- La Cañada Kiwanis Club
- Assistance League of Flintridge

It is important to note, there are many other local organization, businesses, and churches that provide one time or ongoing events to the community that Senior Citizens may participate in. For example, organizations such as Chamber of Commerce, JPL and La Cañada Flintridge Riding Club host events for the Community which senior citizens may participate in. The list provided are of

organization with programs specifically for senior citizens. The Commission is welcome to include any organizations that although may not have senior citizen specific programs but do have programs which may be beneficial to the needs assessment process.

Parks and Recreation Commission is asked to review, modify and approve the list of community organization to be invited to a Commission meeting for a presentation on services they provide to the Senior Citizens of La Cañada Flintridge.
