SUBJECT: **Nomination and Election of Parks and Recreation
Commission Representative to the Joint-Use Committee.**

RECOMMENDATION:

Parks and Recreation Commission nominate and vote on a representative to the Joint-Use Committee for fiscal year 2016-17 to serve from July 2016 to June 2017.

BACKGROUND:

The Joint-Use Committee is comprised of two members of the City Council and two members of the School District Board. This committee develops recommendations on issues relating to the maintenance and operation of community facilities covered under the Joint Use Agreement between the school district and the City. The committee meets every other month at 8:30 a.m. The next meeting of the Committee will be held Thursday, July 28, at 8:30 a.m.

The Parks and Recreation Commission annually elects a non-voting representative to the Joint-Use Committee in the month of July to serve a one year term. The primary role of the Parks and Rec. representative is to advise the Joint-Use Committee of Parks and Recreation Commission activities and to report back to the Commission on the activities of the Joint-Use Committee.
