A. The City of La Cañada Flintridge General Plan Update (Case No. GPA 05-01). California state law requires each city to adopt a comprehensive, long-term general plan to guide the physical development of the incorporated city and any land outside of the city boundaries that bears a relationship to its planning activities. The General Plan is the foundation for local land use planning and provides a vision for the City's foreseeable planning period. This General Plan translates the community's long-range vision into goals, objectives, and policies for the future distribution of land uses, both public and private. This General Plan will serve as the blueprint for future growth and development. The plan must contain policies and programs designed to provide decision makers with a solid basis for land use related decisions. The General Plan is the official statement of policies governing all city council, advisory committee, and administrative decisions regarding zoning, subdivisions, and public improvements. The proposed City of La Cañada Flintridge General Plan 2030 update amends the existing General Plan in its entirety. It includes the following elements: Land Use, Open

Space and Recreation, Conservation, Safety, Circulation, Noise, Air Quality, and Housing.


